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OVERVIEW

The 2017 New Zealand Golf Amateur Mixed Foursomes Championship will be run again by PaR nz Golfing Holidays under the auspices of New Zealand Golf and will be hosted for the 3rd year running by Wanaka Golf Club in Otago. Less than an hour's drive from Queenstown Airport, this is an excellent laid out course with spectacular views over Lake Wanaka. Open to any handicap golfer (18 or 9 hole) with a New Zealand DotGolf affiliated handicap, or an equivalent from an overseas club.

All players will be seeded by handicap into divisions of eight, for three (3) rounds of foursomes match play. The top division will play off the stick foursomes match play and the others will all be handicap foursomes match play.

The programme includes a welcome happy hour, breakfast before play on Saturday 21 October and lunch before prize giving after the final rounds on Sunday 22 October. This is a relaxed fun but competitive format - come join the 2017 tournament in a magic part of New Zealand.

TROPHIES & PRIZES

By division, trophies and prizes will be awarded to the Winning Pair, Finalists, Plate winner and Flight winners.

ELIGIBILITY

Players must have a New Zealand Golf Handicap Index of 36.4 or better for men and 40.4 or better for women, or an overseas equivalent. Players must also comply with the Entry requirements as listed in clause 1 ENTRIES.

The 2017 Championship will be played at the Wanaka Golf Club. The maximum field size is 64 mixed pairs. Should entries exceed this number the tournament committee reserve the right to ballot entries by handicap order. Should entries not reach the maximum field size, the tournament committee reserve the right to cap entries to match

equal numbers of eight players, by handicap order (i.e. to avoid byes). The format includes two days of match play. The initial draw is seeded, by the lowest combined handicap.

If inclement weather or for any other reason the event is disrupted the Championship Committee may alter the format and the number of rounds played.

ENTRIES

1. Entries to be made on-line on the PaR nz website www.parnz.co.nz/tournaments or, on the official entry form issued by PaR nz Limited (under contract for NZ Golf Inc). Entries will not be accepted by phone. Entries must be received by the 7 October 2017, (or at an extended date as advised by PaR nz Golfing Holidays).
2. The entry fee is \$150 per player and includes your entry fee, complimentary practice round, breakfast Saturday 21 and lunch Sunday 22 October, and prize giving.
3. PaR nz Limited and / or New Zealand Golf or the host club reserve the right to refuse any entry without being required to give a reason for so refusing.
4. PaR nz Limited or New Zealand Golf at their discretion may accept late entries which may be subject to an additional \$20.
5. Entries must reach the office of PaR nz Limited, P O Box 331395, Takapuna 0740 accompanied by the entry fee, no later than 7 October 2017.
6. Entrants must conform with the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by the R & A Limited. Entrants must sign the appropriate section of the entry form.



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7. The Scoring records of entrants will be reviewed for authenticity through the New Zealand Golf Handicapping website.
 8. It is the player's sole responsibility to ensure his / her entry has been received prior to the closing date. A player's entry has not officially been received until an official letter of receipt is sent to the player or an online confirmation is received.
 9. In the event of applications exceeding the number of places available in the field, the tournament committee may increase the number of divisions played or, accept entries in order based on handicap. Entry fees will be refunded to those entrants balloted out.
 10. Entry fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the closing date for entries, less an administration fee of \$30 per entry, except for those entrants who may be balloted out and do not subsequently compete.
 11. The data contained in the entry form submitted by the entrant is permanently retained by New Zealand Golf / PaR nz Limited within its database of competitors details. From time to time New Zealand Golf / PaR nz Limited may allow a sponsor or golf clubs to utilise the information contained.
 12. By entering this PaR nz Golfing Holidays event managed tournament, event or tour, you agree to be added to the PaR nz Golfing Holidays database and to receive electronic ongoing communications including email newsletters, electronic flyers and materials as may be sent by post, including specific updates as they pertain to the event you have just entered.
 13. After entries are accepted partners may be changed where one is incapacitated as long as the new partner has the same or lower handicap than the original. The Tournament Director must be notified within 24 hours.
5. Motorised Vehicles: During play it is prohibited for a player to ride in or on a motorised vehicle, unless granted permission under the New Zealand Golf Use of a Motorised Cart Policy. Penalty 2 strokes in stroke play for each hole where a breach occurs. Maximum penalty per round 4 strokes. In match play loss of hole, maximum penalty per round loss of 2 holes.
 6. In this competition a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.
 7. Pace of Play Guidelines: Competitors will be issued with the New Zealand Golf policy for Pace of Play. It covers your responsibility to retain your place in the field, and an indication of how long you have to play shots. The penalties indicated in the policy will be enforced.
 8. Drugs Policy: All competitors are subject to drug testing for banned substances as laid down by the New Zealand Golf Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy or refusing to take a test may be disqualified.
 9. Code of Conduct: All competitors are responsible for conducting themselves to the high standard expected at New Zealand Golf events. The New Zealand Golf Disciplinary Policy will be enforced if it is deemed necessary.
 10. All competitors participate in the tournament at their own risk. The Tournament Committee, PaR nz Limited, sponsors, host golf club and other suppliers of goods or services accept no liability for any death, injury, property loss or damage incurred during or arising out of any aspect of the conduct of the Championship.

REGISTRATION

All competitors must register in person on Saturday 21 October prior to commencing play. Failure to do so may result in their place being taken by someone else.

GENERAL RULES OF PLAY

1. The Rules of Play shall be the 2016 Rules of Golf as approved by the R & A Rules Limited, together with Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Committee.
2. Publishing of Draws: The draw will be available on www.parnz.co.nz / www.nzgolf.org.nz following the close of entries. Draws during the event will be posted as soon as possible after the completion of play. Match play draws will be made in accordance with the automatic draw.
3. Golf Balls: It is a condition of the Championship that only those balls published in the current list of Confirming Golf Balls issued by the R & A Limited may be used in the Championship. The penalty for the use of a brand not listed is disqualification.
4. Driving Clubs: Spring Effect and Dynamic Properties – Appendix ii (IV) c (page 173, Rules of Golf applies). Penalty for breach of condition – Disqualification.

CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

The Championship Committee shall comprise the New Zealand Golf / PaR nz Tournament Director, the Rules Chairman and a Host Golf Club representative. The Championship Committee will decide all disputes, will be responsible for all arrangements and may, if necessary, postpone any event or alter the order of events or starting times. In the absence of the full Championship Committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision and any decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee. The Championship Committee's decision on matters affecting the Championship shall be final. Any dispute or protest must be lodged in writing and submitted to the Championship Committee within fifteen (15) minutes of the conclusion of the day's play. New Zealand Golf, PaR nz Limited and the Championship Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry without being required to give a reason for so refusing.



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
