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OVERVIEW

The 2019 New Zealand Men's Mid-Amateur will be combined and played simultaneously with The 2019 New Zealand Women's Mid-Amateur at the Omanu Golf Course situated in the coastal haven of Mt Maunganui in the Bay of Plenty region. The Championship is a 54-hole stroke play tournament by age group.

An exciting enhancement to the tournament is the awarding of two places at the 2019 Australian Mid-Amateur for the men's and women's winners (providing the winners are New Zealander's) or the top placed New Zealand male and female competitors. This will include tournament entry and a travel grant to assist with flights to the 2019 Australian Mid-Amateur Championship including tournament clothing.

The Omanu Golf Course will, for the third year running, host the 2019 Championship. It is a superb championship course layout, located close to beaches, cafe's and good quality accommodation.

2019 RULES

Please note that the new rules will come into effect from 1st January 2019. These will be published by the R&A and USGA in September 2018. All players will be notified of these changes before the commencement of play.

ELIGIBILITY

Players must be over 30 years of age, as at 11 January 2019, and have a New Zealand Golf Handicap Index not exceeding 14.0 (men) and 24.0 (women) or an overseas equivalent. (Note – the tournament committee accepts that handicaps may alter from the time of entry to the start of the tournament, and may accept players with slightly higher handicaps at their discretion).

FORMAT

Both Trophies, the Neil Woodbury Mid Amateur Cup and the New Zealand Women's Masters Shield, donated by the Women's Trust Fund, will be awarded to the overall lowest gross winner, man and woman, over 54 holes. Additional Gross, Net and Stableford prizes by division and age will be awarded, the final split advised when entries close and the field is full.

18 holes each day will be played – Friday 11th, Saturday 12th and Sunday 13th of January. The event is a 54 hole stroke play championship. In the event of a tie for the overall championship, those players tied will play off in a sudden death format as selected by the Championship Committee. This shall continue until a winner is determined. If for any reason this is not possible, joint winners will be declared.

All other prizes and places shall be decided by count back, of the last 18 holes, 9, 6, 3, and then 1. If still tied, the winner shall be decided by lot. If inclement weather affects any round the Championship Committee may alter the format and the numbers of rounds played. All prizes will be distributed in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status. The field will be limited to the first 120 paid entries received.

The Tournament Director reserves the right to make amendments according to the final split of entries, by age, handicap and gender, with final divisions advised when entries are closed. Additional entries may be considered outside the listed handicap ranges at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

ENTRIES

1. Entries shall only be made online on the PaR nz website www.parnz.co.nz/tournaments or on the official entry form.



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- The entry fee is \$165 per person for the three days tournament and includes lunch at the awards function.
- PaR nz Limited and / or New Zealand Golf or the host club reserve the right to refuse any entry without being required to give a reason for so refusing.
- Entrants must conform with the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by the R & A Rules Limited. Entrants must sign the appropriate section of the entry form.
- The Scoring records of entrants will be reviewed for authenticity through the New Zealand Golf Handicapping website.
- It is the player's sole responsibility to ensure his/ her entry has been received prior to the closing date. A player's entry has not officially been received until an official letter of receipt is sent to the player or an online confirmation is received.
- Entry fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the closing date. Refunds will only be issued where written advice is received and subject to an administration fee of \$30. Refunds will be issued to those entrants who may be balloted out and do not subsequently compete.
- The data contained in the entry form submitted by the entrants is permanently retained by Par nz Limited / New Zealand Golf within its database of competitors. From time to time New Zealand Golf may allow a sponsor or Golf Clubs to utilise the information obtained.
- strokes. In match play loss of hole, maximum penalty per round loss of 2 holes.
- Measuring Devices: In this competition a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his/her play (e.g., gradient, wind-speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3 for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.
- Pace of Play Guideline: Competitors will be issued with the New Zealand Golf policy for Pace of Play. It covers your responsibility to retain your place in the field, and an indication of how long you have to play shots. The penalties indicated in the policy will be enforced.
- Drugs Policy: All competitors are subject to drug testing for banned substances as laid down by the New Zealand Golf Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy or refusing to take a test may be disqualified.
- Code of Conduct: All competitors are responsible for conducting themselves to the high standard expected at New Zealand Golf and PaR nz Limited events. The New Zealand Golf Disciplinary Policy will be enforced if it is deemed necessary.
- All competitors participate in the tournament at their own risk. The Tournament Committee, PaR nz Limited, sponsors, host golf club and other suppliers of goods or services accept no liability for any death, injury, property loss or damage incurred during or arising out of any aspect of the conduct of the Championship.

REGISTRATION

All competitors must register at the Host Golf Club on Thursday 10 January 2.00pm – 4.00pm, or Friday 11 January from 8.00am – 11.00am. Failure to do so may result in their place being taken by someone else.

GENERAL RULES OF PLAY

- The Rules of Play shall be the Rules of Golf as approved by the R & A Rules Limited, together with Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Committee.
- Publishing of Draws: The draw will be available on www.parnz.co.nz and www.golf.co.nz following the close of entries. Draws during the event will be posted as soon as possible after the completion of play.
- Golf Balls: It is a condition of the Championship that only those balls published in the current list of Conforming Golf Balls issued by the R & A may be used in the Championship. The penalty for the use of a brand not listed is disqualification.
- Motorised Vehicles: During play it is prohibited for a player to ride in or on a motorised vehicle, unless granted permission under the New Zealand Golf Use of a Motorised Cart Policy. Penalty 2 strokes in stroke play for each hole where a breach occurs. Maximum penalty per round 4

PUBLICITY

PaR nz Golfing Holidays / NZ Golf Inc. may arrange media promotion and publicity before, during and after the Championship. Competitions assent to references to them and pictures of them appearing and being used for purposes determined by PaR nz Golfing Holidays / NZ Golf Inc.

CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

The Championship Committee shall comprise the New Zealand Golf Tournament Director, the rules Chairman and a Host Golf Club representative. The Championship Committee will decide all disputes, will be responsible for all arrangements and may, if necessary, postpone any event or alter the order of events or starting times. In the absence of the full Championship Committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision and any decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee. The Championship Committee's decision on matters affecting the Championship shall be final. Any dispute or protest must be lodged in writing and submitted to the Championship Committee within fifteen (15) minutes of the conclusion of the day's play. New Zealand Golf, PaR nz Limited and the Championship Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry without being required to give a reason for so refusing.



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
